



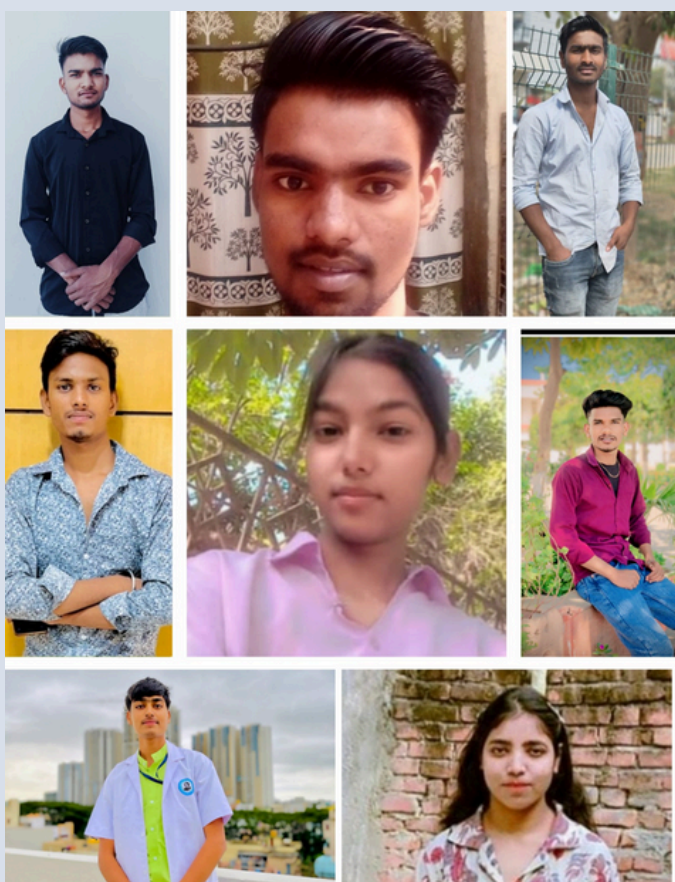
SHIKSHA PRAYAS
